• The City of De Soto was awarded funds for **1** project. Applicants will be considered on a first come, first serve basis.

• The interested family or individual within De Soto city limits completes and submits an application to Region XII. All personal information is kept strictly confidential. Rentals and homes purchased through a land contract are not eligible.

• After a family is deemed eligible a housing inspector will contact the homeowner for an initial inspection to determine what repairs are needed. Repairs will follow FHLB Housing Standards guidelines.

• The eligible household may receive up to \$15,000-\$17,000 in rehabilitation funds.

• These funds are in the form of a 5-year forgivable loan.
