

CITY OF DESOTO – REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

April 20, 2021 – Mayor Butch Ostrander called the meeting to order at 7:00pm; The City of De Soto met via an electronic meeting due to Iowa Governor Kim Reynold’s Proclamation of Disaster Emergency, which among other matters, ordered the prohibition of community gatherings of ten or more people at all locations. Therefore, in-person meetings of the City Council are impossible or impractical as contemplated by Iowa Code Section 21.4(1) (b).

Motion by Bach/Hansen to approve Iowa Pump Works estimate of \$8,677.50 for a new MBBR influent pump at the WWTP; Bach, Golightly, Hansen, Padget, Wilson in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Wilson/Bach to set May 18, 2021 @7:00p.m. for a public hearing for the voluntary annexation of approximately 90 acres of land south of Spruce Street owned by LeMar Koethe; Bach, Golightly, Hansen, Padget, Wilson in favor; Motion carried 5-0.
