

CITY OF DESOTO – REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

October 21, 2025 – Mayor Crozier called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Answering roll call was: Ted Davis, Wade Fox, Bobby Huntoon and Dustin Padget; Josh Minton arrived @6:12p.m.

Staff present included City Clerk Marcia Thomas, Police Chief Josh Sienkiewicz, Public Works Director Dan Van Lengen, Library Director Brianna Glen, Assistant Fire Chief Tim Murray and City Attorney DuWayne Dalen.

Motion by Davis/Huntoon to approve the agenda; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Padget in favor; Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Padget/Davis to approve the consent agenda; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Padget in favor; Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Crozier opened the Public Hearing on plans and specifications, proposed form of contract and estimate of cost for construction of the De Soto Fire Station for the City of De Soto, Iowa @ 6:19p.m. Clerk Thomas said she received no phone calls or written correspondence regarding the Public Hearing. With no questions or concerns from the audience, Mayor Crozier closed the Public Hearing @ 6:20p.m.

Motion by Minton/Padget to approve Resolution 2026-10; A Resolution approving the plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the De Soto Fire Station Project; Roll Call vote taken; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Minton/Padget to approve Resolution 2026-11; A Resolution awarding contract for the De Soto Fire Station Project to Edge Companies located in Grimes, Iowa; Roll Call vote taken; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Padget/Minton to approve Resolution 2026-12; A Resolution directing the acceptance of a proposal to purchase \$2,500,000 (Dollar amount subject to change) General Obligation Capital Loan Notes, Series 2025B and moved that it be adopted; Roll Call vote taken; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Padget/Huntoon to approve Resolution 2026-13; A Resolution waiving the right to review of the Plat of Survey for parcel 25-106, Dallas County, Iowa; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Fox/Davis to approve the City of De Soto Annual Financial Report for fiscal year ending June 30, 2025; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Fox/Davis to approve ISG Engineering Services Agreement; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Padget/Minton to approve ISG Engineering Agreement for the Water Treatment Plant filter addition; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Items No. 8 & 9 were tabled.

Motion by Huntoon/Davis to approve Alex McCune, Josh Minton and Charles Rice, pending background checks, to be members of the De Soto Fire & Rescue Department; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padget in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Fox/Huntoon to approve estimate of \$32,901.63 for 3 handheld Motorola radios with required equipment purchased from Unplugged Wireless for the De Soto Police Department; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padgett in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Padgett/Huntoon to approve estimate of \$1,630.00 from Electric Pump for the Water Treatment Plant CIP tank pumps (for the RO unit); Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padgett in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Minton/Huntoon to hire Brad Parks for the regular part-time public works position working 16-20 hours weekly and starting wage of \$17.00 per hour; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padgett in favor; Motion carried 5-0.

Item No. 14 was tabled.

Having no other business Mayor Crozier asked for a motion to adjourn; Motion by Minton/Davis to adjourn @7:24p.m.; Davis, Fox, Huntoon, Minton, Padgett in favor; Motion carried 5-0.
