Motion by Olson/Eckstein to approve Nelson Insurance Agency 2026 insurance premium proposal of \$103,174; ; Davis, Eckstein, Huntoon, Olson in favor; Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Huntoon/Eckstein to approve the revisions made by ISG Engineering for Chapter 90 Water Service System, Chapter 90 Water Service System, Chapter 91 Water Meters, Chapter 95 Sanitary Sewer System, Chapter 96 Building Sewers and Connections, Chapter 97 Use of Public Sewers, Chapter 98 On-Site Wastewater Systems; Davis, Eckstein, Huntoon, Olson in favor; Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Huntoon/Eckstein to approve estimate of \$160,171.25 from Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation for the Elm Street resurfacing project; Davis, Eckstein, Huntoon, Olson in favor; Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Olson/Davis to discuss retaining Police Department 2015 Chevrolet Suburban for incident command/training use vehicle for the Fire Department; Discussion took place; No action taken.

Motion by Olson to approve the Fire Department keep the 2015 Chevrolet Suburban for incident command/training use; Motion failed for no second.

Motion by Davis/Eckstein to approve the City of De Soto sell the 2015 Chevrolet Suburban; Davis, Eckstein, Huntoon in favor; Olson opposed; Motion carried 3-1.

Discussion took place regarding Riva Walters property located @ 123 Cedar Street, De Soto; Ms. Walters is wanting to build a house on this property; the property is in a flood plain; Ms. Walters has been in discussion with the DNR and will submit a site plan to V & K Engineering for their review.
